- \* demonstrated the skills required to work autonomously with specific tasks in the main field of study.

Judgement and approach

For a Higher education diploma the student shall have:

- \* demonstrated knowledge about and be equipped to deal with ethical issues in the main field of study

Knowledge and understanding

For a University Diploma students must

- demonstrate knowledge and understanding of their main field of study, including an awareness of the scientific basis of the field and knowledge of some applicable methods in the field.

Skills and abilities

For a University Diploma students must

- demonstrate an ability to seek, gather and critically interpret relevant information so as to formulate answers to well-defined questions in their main field of study; - demonstrate an ability to present their knowledge and discuss it with different groups; and - demonstrate the skills required to work independently with certain tasks in the field that the education concerns.

Judgement and approach

## Detailed objectives for this degree

To achieve a university diploma for the Gemstone Technology programme, the student shall:

- Be well informed of various minerals and rocks, suitable for producing Gem stones
- Have good knowledge of practices for treating, forming and design of various gem stone products.
- Have good knowledge and insight of Gemstone handling from a company and a market perspective.

## Credits

The programme requires 120 credits.

## Special requirements

### Higher Education Ordinance and Luleå University of Technology

Independent project (diploma project)
