Course Aim

Students will after the course know how to use free hand drawing for visualization and communication. The student will know how to draw 1-, 2- and 3-point perspective, constructed or from an original. They will understand how to use light and shadows in drawings, and analyze and visualize material properties. The aim is that the students will learn to understand and implement drawing as a tool to visualize ideas and concepts in product design, and practice on using the material and manners that are accustomed in the field.

Contents

Practical training in drawing to understand eye levels, perspectives, proportions, foreshortenings, lighting, shading and material representations. The course also include basic technique training.

Realization

Each course occasion's language and form is stated and appear on the course page on Luleå University of Technology's website.

Lectures and practical training with supervising individually and in groups. Assignments initiated during class but finished during the students study time. Attendance on lectures is compulsory.

Examination
