Course Aim

Students will after the course know how to produce professional sketches to visualize ideas and concepts in the field of Architecture. Students will train to discuss and give and take critics in oral presentations. Students will know how to use light and shadows and also use software to assemble and adjust drawings.

Contents

- Training in using shadows and light, coloring
- Training to use different rendering techniques
- Training in analyzing built environment by using sketches
- Training in making collage with people ,rooms and detail studies.
- Training to assemble and shape up sketches by using software
