Selection

The selection is based on final school grades or Swedish Scholastic Aptitude Test.

Course Aim

Upon completion of the course, the student will demonstrate

- basic knowledge and skills in singing
- basic knowledge and skills in playing chords on the chosen chordal instrument
- basic skills in accompanying one's own singing.

Contents

The course consists of two parts

- chordal instruments
- singing

Realization

Each course occasion's language and form is stated and appear on the course page on Luleå University of Technology's website.

Teaching is carried out with joint and individual lessons in singing and instruments.

Examination

If there is a decision on special educational support, in accordance with the Guideline Student's rights and obligations at Luleå University of Technology, an adapted or alternative form of examination can be provided. Examination takes place through a sound report and a final report in a group.

Unauthorized aids during exams and assessments

If a student, by using unauthorized aids, tries to mislead during an exam or when a study performance is to be assessed, disciplinary measures may be taken. The term "unauthorized aids" refers to aids that the teacher has not previously specified as permissible aids and that may assist in solving the examination task. This means that all aids not specified as permissible are prohibited. The Swedish version has interpretative precedence in the event of a conflict.
