## Course Aim

After having accomplished the course the student should be able to

- Define basic concepts related to entrepreneurship
- On a fundamental level explain the impact that entrepreneurship have for the individual, for the organization and for society
- Display deeper knowledge and insights in a few chosen areas of entrepreneurship

## Contents

Entrepreneurship is needed to achieve renewal in all areas, including private business, public organizations, the school system and the social sector. This course is therefore addressing students in all disciplines that are interested in entrepreneurship as a phenomenon. In this basic course, you will be experiencing several perspectives of entrepreneurship and its role and significance in these different contexts. The different perspectives include the individual, collaboration, business, society, social and learning. Apart from common compulsory assignments that everybody does, students also choose a specific assignment to be done individually or in a group that address the perspectives listed above.

## Realization

Each course occasion's language and form is stated and appear on the course page on Luleå University of Technology's website.

The teaching is done through lectures and seminars. The course includes a major project work in any area related to entrepreneurship, which is performed independently under supervision.

## Examination

If there is a decision on special educational support, in accordance with the Guideline Student's rights and obligations at Luleå University of Technology, an adapted or alternative form of examination can be provided. Examination is accomplished through compulsory assignments to be done individually and in group.
