The selection is based on final school grades or Swedish Scholastic Aptitude Test.

- communicate in and understand spoken and written English from different registers and at different levels of formality
- demonstrate basic knowledge of applied phonetics
- demonstrate knowledge of how the English language is structured
- read, understand and analyse literary texts in English using basic literary terminology
- demonstrate knowledge and understanding of literary texts in English in their cultural, historical and linguistic contexts
- show a good understanding of the relationship between language and society and how this is manifested in language use
- show awareness of how the use and understanding of English is impacted by context and word meaning
