Course Aim

By the end of this course, the student shall be able to:

- · describe the main features of Western philosophy from ancient Greece to approximately the year 1900
- relate some of the issues discussed in the history of philosophy to more modern discussions
- show basic argumentative and interpretative skills relating to problems in the history of philosophy

Contents

The course provides a basic overview of central problems and figures in the history of Western philosophy. Examples of figures presented by the course are Plato, Aristotle, Descartes, Leibniz, Hume and Kant. Emphasis is placed on philosophical understanding and not on the biographical or historical context of ideas.

Realization

Each course occasion's language and form is stated and appear on the course page on Luleå University of Technology's website.

The teacher-controlled tuition consists of lectures and seminars.
