# **Course Aim**

By the end of this course, the student shall be able to:

- apply methods of informal logic; describe and evaluate arguments,
- give accounts of and apply thinking tools belonging to the semantics,
- describe elementary logical concepts and apply propositional logic.

# Contents

The course offers basic training in philosophical method. The course consists of the following parts:

Part 1: Informal logic. The basic concepts and methods of informal logic are introduced. Descriptive and evaluative analyses of arguments are carried out.

Part 2: Semantics. This part aims to introduce the fundamental issues and concepts of semantics.

Part 3: Introduction to logic. Logic has, since Aristotle, been proposed as a general theory about valid arguments. In this part, propositional logic is used as a tool for deciding the validity of inferences.

# Realization

Each course occasion's language and form is stated and appear on the course page on Luleå University of Technology's website.

Teaching consists of lectures and group exercises.
