Course Aim

The aim of the Course are to give the student a working knowledge of playing and registration technique at an historic instrument as well as the ability to adapt baroque music to other organs.

Contents

Led by eminent musicians and pedagogues, the student will be working with interpretation (both musically and technically) of repertoire adapted to the student's instrumental level and skill. The teaching will be done in Masterclasses. Individual lessons may also occur. The course also contains several seminars including discussions and reflections, and official concerts.

Realization

Each course occasion's language and form is stated and appear on the course page on Luleå University of Technology's website.

The course takes place at Lövstabruk, Tierp, Sweden, in the summer of 2019, during "The International Organ Academy".

Examination
