Entry requirements

In order to meet the general entry requirements for first cycle studies you must have successfully completed upper secondary education and documented skills in English language and completed compulsory courses of at least 60 credits from the Bachelor Programme in Music with at least the grade Pass. The following course should be included: Musical Profile - Classical Musician 3 (F0319G or F0264G) 15 credits, or equivalent knowledge.

Selection

The selection is based on 1-165 credits.

Course Aim

1. Knowledge and understanding

Upon completion of the course, the student shall

- demonstrate good knowledge and understanding of musical, technical and methodological aspects of their own musical practice
- demonstrate good knowledge and understanding of the conditions and requirements associated with ensemble playing in different instrumental constellations
- demonstrate good knowledge and understanding of stage-related aspects of music performance

2. Competence and skill

Upon completion of the course, the student shall

- be able to demonstrate good skills in rehearsing assigned repertoire
- be able to demonstrate good ability to perform artistic assignments individually and in groups
- be able to demonstrate good ability to perform music with a deliberate stage expression

3. Judgement and approach

Upon completion of the course, the student shall

- be able to reflect in depth on their own development of instrumental skills
- be able to reflect in depth on their own learning

Contents

The course includes

- Instrument or vocals, individually or in groups
- Ensemble performance, vocals and/or instrument

Realization

Each course occasion's language and form is stated and appear on the course page on Luleå University of Technology's website.

- individual and group instruction, supervision and ensemble rehearsals

Examination

If there is a decision on special educational support, in accordance with the Guideline Student's rights and obligations at Luleå University of Technology, an adapted or alternative form of examination can be provided. In the Instrument/Vocals component, examination of Competence and skill is by means of practical demonstration.

In the Ensemble performance, instrument/vocals component, examination of competence and skills is done on an ongoing basis through practical demonstration in connection with rehearsals and concerts.

Examination of Knowledge and understanding and Judgement and approach is done on an ongoing basis through practical demonstration and oral examination.

Unauthorized aids during exams and assessments

If a student, by using unauthorized aids, tries to mislead during an exam or when a study performance is to be assessed, disciplinary measures may be taken. The term "unauthorized aids" refers to aids that the teacher has not previously specified as permissible aids and that may assist in solving the examination task. This means that all aids not specified as permissible are prohibited. The Swedish version has interpretative precedence in the event of a conflict.

Remarks

Students must register for the courses themselves, or contact ETKS educational administration eduetks@ltu.se, not later than three days after the quarter commences. Failure to do so can result in the place being lost. This rule also applies to students with a guaranteed place.
