Course Aim

This course aims to provide students with heightened knowledge and comprehension of their roll as an orchestra musician. Upon course completion, the student will be expected to demonstrate:

- Good knowledge of classical orchestra repertoire and the skills to study this repertoire alone or in a group
- Competence in musician interaction and cooperative listening
- Competence in personal performance and artistic creation of classical music
- Competence in intonation, timbre, balance, tone creation, rhythm, articulation, and other musical attributes essential to symphony orchestra musicianship
- Adequate appreciation of scenic expressio
