Entry requirements

In order to meet the general entry requirements for first cycle studies you must have successfully completed upper secondary education and documented skills in English language and Health Promotion.

Selection

The selection is based on 1-165 credits.

Course Aim

On completion of the course, students should, with a scientific and ethical approach, based on the contents of the course, be able to:

- 1. Describe the characteristic features of the project process, preconditions and challenges related to health guidance within the health promotion perspective.
- 2. Apply the project process within the framework of health guidance and argue for the health promotion basis of the project.
- 3. Describe the basics of entrepreneurship and how they apply to the professional field of health guidance.
- 4. Identify, analyse and formulate a business concept in health guidance.

Contents

- · Inventory and evaluation of a health project
- The project process and its connection to health promotion and health guidance
- Team development, leadership in a project group
- Entrepreneurship and economic conditions for business
- The business process and business plan design
- Career planning

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• Clinical health project that is planned and carried out in collaboration with the employer.



Realization

Each course occasion's language and form is stated and appear on the course page on Luleå University of Technology's website.

The course is given by distance learning and is mainly web-based. The studies require computer experience and access to a broadband connection (at least 0.5 Mb/s, preferably 2.0 Mb/s) as well as a headset and web camera. Parts of the course are located on campus where above all seminars and examinations take place. In order to complete the course, the student should actively seek knowledge and solve problems using an inquiring and critically reflective approach. This means that the student should take responsibility by actively contributing to the achievement of course objectives through the planning of content and time. The contents of the course are treated through group work, clinical project work, lectures, oral and written presentations and seminars. Course requirements are completed study assignments as well as compulsory attendance and an active participation in discussions at seminars. This course is part of the health guidance programme. The program has a consistent pedagogical strategy that stimulates an active learning where team development and career planning are recurrent elements in the courses. The group work aims to develop skills that can only be trained through interaction and the sharing of experience with others.

Examination

If there is a decision on special educational support, in accordance with the Guideline Student's rights and obligations at Luleå University of Technology, an adapted or alternative form of examination can be provided. Aim 1 is examined individually and in groups using written and verbal examination (Code 0008). Aim 2 is carried out individually and in groups through active participation in live project work placement and examined using written rapport and verbal presentation in seminar (Code 0002). Aim 3 is examined individually using written rapport (Code 0007). Aim 4 is examined individually and in groups using written rapports (Code 0006).

Criteria for a pass and pass with distinction are stated in the study guide.

Unauthorized aids during exams and assessments

If a student, by using unauthorized aids, tries to mislead during an exam or when a study performance is to be assessed, disciplinary measures may be taken. The term "unauthorized aids" refers to aids that the teacher has not previously specified as permissible aids and that may assist in solving the examination task. This means that all aids not specified as permissible are prohibited. The Swedish version has interpretative precedence in the event of a conflict.
