Entry requirements

In order to meet the general entry requirements for first cycle studies you must have successfully completed upper secondary education and documented skills in English language

Selection

The selection is based on final school grades or Swedish Scholastic Aptitude Test.

Course Aim

After completing the course the student will be able to:

- 1. identify and describe existing areas of health promotion where ICT is used as a tool.
- 2. analyze and evaluate how ICT can be used to facilitate and develop health guidance.
- 3. critically examine and reflect on ICTs as tools through an ethical and empowerment perspective.
- 4. develop and present a project idea and project plan where ICT in health promotion / health guidance can be tested or implemented in a company or organization.

Contents

- Theoretical knowledge in the field of e-health, ie the development of Internet and mobile technology and its application in the area of health promotion.
- Regional, national and international research and development projects in the e-health area.
- Empowerment and applications of ICT support as well as ethical issues involved.

Realization

Each course occasion's language and form is stated and appear on the course page on Luleå University of Technology's website.

The course is given via distance learning. For the implementation of the course, it is assumed that the student actively seeks knowledge and solves problems through an investigative and critically reflective way of working. This means that the student takes personal responsibility by actively participating in achieving the goals of the course by planning content and time. The content of the course is processed through literature studies, group work, lectures, oral and written presentations and seminars. Course requirements are completed study assignments as well as mandatory attendance and active participation in discussions at seminars. Working in groups aims to develop skills that can only be trained through interaction and exchange of experience with others.
