Entry requirements

In order to meet the general entry requirements for first cycle studies you must have successfully completed upper secondary education and documented skills in English language + completed course Basic music theory course (eg H0043G) 7.5 credits with at least the grade Pass, or music line from Folk High School or Ear- and music theory 2 from Aesthetic line, or equivalent knowledge. Documentation proving special eligibility is uploaded on antagning.se in connection with the application.

Selection

The selection is based on final school grades or Swedish Scholastic Aptitude Test.

Course Aim

Knowledge and understanding

Upon completion of the course, the student will demonstrate

- increased knowledge of, and understanding of, the subject of composition.
- be able to demonstrate increased knowledge of the musical craft: compositional techniques seen from historical, functional, philosophical and artistic perspectives.

Competence and skills

Upon completion of the course, the student will demonstrate

- developed skills in composition.
- be able to demonstrate skills in processing a musical idea based on the musical parameters.

Judgement and approach

Upon completion of the course, the student will demonstrate

- reflection on one's own development and one's own learning.

Contents

Composition exercises and own composing of sounding music. Analyzes of contemporary and classical compositional techniques, artistic and ideological starting points. The course is designed individually based on the student's prior knowledge.

Realization

Each course occasion's language and form is stated and appear on the course page on Luleå University of Technology's website.

Individual tutoring and group seminars.

Examination

If there is a decision on special educational support, in accordance with the Guideline Student's rights and obligations at Luleå University of Technology, an adapted or alternative form of examination can be provided. Presentation of composition exercises and own composition for ensemble of choice.

Unauthorized aids during exams and assessments

If a student, by using unauthorized aids, tries to mislead during an exam or when a study performance is to be assessed, disciplinary measures may be taken. The term “unauthorized aids” refers to aids that the teacher has not previously specified as permissible aids and that may assist in solving the examination task. This means that all aids not specified as permissible are prohibited. The Swedish version has interpretative precedence in the event of a conflict.

Remarks

Students must register for the courses themselves, or contact ETKS educational administration eduetks@ltu.se, not later than three days after the quarter commences. Failure to do so can result in the place being lost. This rule also applies to students with a guaranteed place.
