Entry requirements

In order to meet the general entry requirements for first cycle studies you must have successfully completed upper secondary education and documented skills in English language

Selection

The selection is based on final school grades or Swedish Scholastic Aptitude Test.

Course Aim

Students shall after completion of the course be able to:

- Describe and give examples of the interplay between technical, social and political changes.
- Identify and describe the processes behind the driving forces regarding technical development, but also describe and give examples behind processes which lead to failures.
- Give several examples on how human activities on separate locations and times influenced life in general, society, and the surrounding environment.

Contents

The course is a study of technological history from prehistory to today. The course design is based on innovations which are considered the most important for social development in Sweden and the rest of the world. The course is organized around themes such as health, gender, environment, and communication.

Realization

Each course occasion's language and form is stated and appear on the course page on Luleå University of Technology's website.

Net based distance course. Lectures and guidance for the studies is done online so a computer and connection to the internet is necessary.

Examination

If there is a decision on special educational support, in accordance with the Guideline Student's rights and obligations at Luleå University of Technology, an adapted or alternative form of examination can be provided. Take-home exam. Grading system: Swedish grades U, G, VG.

Unauthorized aids during exams and assessments

If a student, by using unauthorized aids, tries to mislead during an exam or when a study performance is to be assessed, disciplinary measures may be taken. The term "unauthorized aids" refers to aids that the teacher has not previously specified as permissible aids and that may assist in solving the examination task. This means that all aids not specified as permissible are prohibited. The Swedish version has interpretative precedence in the event of a conflict.
