Entry requirements

In order to meet the general entry requirements for first cycle studies you must have successfully completed upper secondary education and documented skills in English language and completed the course Legal introduction course (J0046N) 15 credits with at least a passing grade, or equivalent.

Selection

The selection is based on 1-165 credits.

Course Aim

To provide knowledge in current regulations regarding salary and estate tax with a focus on company taxation.

Contents

In tax law the fundamental questions regarding general taxation as well as the delimitation of tax on revenue, tax evaluations of revenue, delimitation of allowable deductions. Furthermore the interpretation and application of tax laws, Swedish international tax law, tax evasion and administrative fees, taxation procedure and tax revenues from "services", "capital", and "business profits".

Realization

Each course occasion's language and form is stated and appear on the course page on Luleå University of Technology's website.

Instruction consists of lectures and group exercises.
