Entry requirements

In order to meet the general entry requirements for first cycle studies you must have successfully completed upper secondary education and documented skills in English language and completed courses of at least 60 credits, with at least the grade Pass, of which 15 credits in industrial engineering and management such as Industrial management with a sustainability perspective (G0010N) 7,5 credits, Sustainable development (L0010N) 7,5 credits, Ecology and environmental science (N0005P) 7,5 credits, Quality management; introduction course (K0001N) 7,5 credits, or equivalent knowledge.

Selection

The selection is based on 1-165 credits.

Course Aim

After completing this course each student shall:

- Be able to explain why an arbitrary organization works with environmental issues and describe which tools they can use
- Be able to account for the community's view on environmental work within organizations and relate it to the international standard ISO 14001
- Independently be able to perform the planning phase of an environmental management system including: -Identification and evaluation of environmental aspects
 - -Formulation of policy, objectives, targets and programmes
- Be able to take active part in teams who develops environmental management systems in an organization with reference to implementing, checking and auditing
- Be able to perform simple Life Cycle Assessments according to the structure in ISO standards.

Contents

A survey of the international standards that are available for use and the core elements within an environmental management system. In addition to standardised environmental management systems certain strategies used in environmental tools are covered. The course also contains a exposition of Swedish environmental legislation concerning permits and supervision.
