Entry requirements

In order to meet the general entry requirements for first cycle studies you must have successfully completed upper secondary education and documented skills in English language and Basic Anatomy and Physiology (M0024H/M0080H, M0025H/M0077H)

Selection

The selection is based on 1-165 credits.

Course Aim

On completion of the course, the student should be able to:

- Give an account of etiology, epidemiology, pathophysiology, diagnostics, treatment, complications and prognosis in commonly occurring neurological, psychiatric, geriatric and child neurological conditions
- Give an account of brain structures and functions, perception and memory functions
- Describe the significance of age and gender for illness and treatment
- Place his knowledge in a larger social context and medical public health perspective in order to be able to participate in health promotion work
- Apply basic hygiene procedures in his/her professional practice
- The value of his knowledge and the need for skills development in respective areas

This knowledge provides a basis for future courses and is a prerequisite for being able to work as a physiotherapist.

Realization

Examination
