Course Aim

- independently be able to collect, analyse and communicate medical information for diagnostics, pharmacological and non-pharmacological treatment as a basis for identifying and carrying out nursing
- from evidence-based knowledge and best proven experience be familiar with the most common and most serious diseases' aetiology, pathophysiology, symptomatology, diagnostics, prevention, treatment and rehabilitation
- · be able to plan, implement and evaluate general and specific nursing related to the most common and most serious diseases of the elderly
- be able to see signs of disease in the elderly and relate these to medical diagnoses
- be able to relate aging and its medical consequences to anatomic and physiological changes
- show safety in assessing and acting in sudden disease in the elderly, for example related to bleeding, sepsis,
- be familiar with statistical methods common in the presentation of research results within geriatric care.

Contents

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The course includes deepened studies of common/central problem areas in the geriatric patient. These fields are studied from a nursing and a medical perspective. Examples of problem areas that will be studied are: immobility, incontinence, intellectual decline, iatrogenesis, malnutrition, depressed mood and confusion. Drug treatment and rehabilitation of the geriatric patient are also studied in the course. 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Realization

Each course occasion's language and form is stated and appear on the course page on Luleå University of Technology's website.

The course is given in collaboration with Umeå University as half-time studies and is web-based. The educational perspective is based on the student having knowledge and experience. The student is assumed to be active and participating in his/her education and responsible for his/her own learning process. The ambition is that the student develops an ability to analyse, explain and evaluate the relationship between the concepts and phenomena that are studied. Learning is stimulated by individual activity, in exchange and interaction with others and linked to the student's own knowledge and earlier experience. The working methods vary between individual work, work in study groups, lectures, literature studies, seminars and directed study assignments adapted to the on-the-job education.

Examination

If there is a decision on special educational support, in accordance with the Guideline Student's rights and obligations at Luleå University of Technology, an adapted or alternative form of examination can be provided. A three-graded scale is used for grading: pass with distinction, pass or fail. The course is examined individually in the form of an examination seminar, a take-home examination and a written assignment.
