Entry requirements

In order to meet the general entry requirements for first cycle studies you must have successfully completed upper secondary education and documented skills in English language

Selection

The selection is based on final school grades or Swedish Scholastic Aptitude Test.

Course Aim

The course is aimed towards individuals that presently or in the future will have a leadership position, and therefore wants to develop their leadership skills. After having passed the course the student should have increased his or her potential to practice effective leadership.

Contents

The course consists of three segments. First, general leadership and motivation models are at focus. Then, group processes are focused where the goal is to understand how to attain effective teams. Third, the focus is on how culture and stress/pressure/change affect the leadership.

Realization

Each course occasion's language and form is stated and appear on the course page on Luleå University of Technology's website.

Lectures, classes and seminars. The course contains guest lectures from the business and public sector.

Examination

If there is a decision on special educational support, in accordance with the Guideline Student's rights and obligations at Luleå University of Technology, an adapted or alternative form of examination can be provided. Compulsory assignments that are presented and discussed in classes and seminars.

Unauthorized aids during exams and assessments

If a student, by using unauthorized aids, tries to mislead during an exam or when a study performance is to be assessed, disciplinary measures may be taken. The term "unauthorized aids" refers to aids that the teacher has not previously specified as permissible aids and that may assist in solving the examination task. This means that all aids not specified as permissible are prohibited. The Swedish version has interpretative precedence in the event of a conflict.

Remarks

Students must register for the courses themselves, or contact ETKS educational administration eduetks@ltu.se, not later than three days after the quarter commences. Failure to do so can result in the place being lost. This rule also applies to students with a guaranteed place.
