Entry requirements

In order to meet the general entry requirements for first cycle studies you must have successfully completed upper secondary education and documented skills in English language and Grundläggande behörighet samt Treårig eftergymnasial sjuksköterskeutbildning från land utanför EU/EES samt Schweiz, av Socialstyrelsen utfärdat beslut om utredning i form av kunskapsprov för sjuksköterskor. Godkända kunskaper i svenska enligt bestämmelser för grundläggande behörighet för grundnivå, Svenska B eller Svenska 3, med lägst betyget godkänd/E. Samt att kursen förutsätter kunskaper motsvarande:

Selection

The selection is based on 1-165 credits.

Course Aim

Upon completion of the course, the student is expected to be able to:

Knowledge and understanding

- Demonstrate the professional skills required to work as a registered nurse in the Swedish healthcare system and in municipal care and welfare services
- provide an account for pathophysiology, aetiology, epidemiology, diagnostics, treatment, the nursing process and prevention in cases of geriatric diseases
- explain health and illness related to human aging and vulnerability in changing life situations
- explain the correlation between aging and medicine-related problems
- describe how illness is expressed and manifested as symptoms in the older person, and how this affects the individual's daily life
- explain the significance of gender and socio-cultural aspects on the potential for gender-equal and fair nursing for elderly people and their next of kin
- describe statutes and local guidelines related to the nursing profession in the care and nursing of elderly people

Competence and skills



- apply planning, organisation and leadership in daily work, and work well in a care team
- collaborate with older persons, their relatives, her/his own profession and representatives of other professions in the care chain
- together with the older person and that person's relatives, prioritise the older person's needs by identifying problems, risks and resources and formulating nursing goals, planning and evaluating nursing measures
- implement and use various methods for assessing pain status, as well as preventing pain and performing pain treatment
- implement and use different methods to assess nutritional status and the risk of falls and pressure ulcers, and undertake adequate nursing measures
- apply and be responsible for reducing the risk of infection and contamination according to the applicable regulations
- calculate, prepare, administer and manage medicinal products correctly and in relation to applicable laws and regulations, and inform the older person about the effects and potential side effects (adverse drug reactions) of the drug in question
- · report and log nursing in the applicable recordkeeping system
- manage medical technology equipment and safely carry out medical technical activities
- critically review and evaluate the quality of nursing, with a starting point in evidence-based knowledge and proven experience
- demonstrate knowledge of leading, organising, prioritising and coordinating nursing work related to the health
 problems and illnesses of the elderly, and nursing that supports the dignity of the elderly late in life and in the
 context of end of life care

Judgement and approach

- reflect on, critically review and evaluate her/his own approach in encounters with the older patient and the patient's relatives
- reflect on and evaluate the importance of personal treatment for the participation of the elderly in their care and nursing
- reflect on dignified nursing in the final stage of life
- reflect on different ethical values, specifically autonomy, integrity and dignity, based on national values for geriatric care
- demonstrate the ability to identify their need for further knowledge in order to develop their professional competence

Realization

Each course occasion's language and form is stated and appear on the course page on Luleå University of Technology's website.

The course modules are implemented with integrated work forms that support the student's understanding, deep learning and autonomy. This is accomplished through knowledge retrieval, problem solving and critical reflection based on the learning outcomes of the course. The student's learning is supported by lectures, laboratory work, simulations, seminars, individual and group assignments, independent study, and supervised clinical practice. Participation and the completion of laboratory sessions, seminars, simulations, assignments and clinical practice are compulsory.

Examination

If there is a decision on special educational support, in accordance with the Guideline Student's rights and obligations at Luleå University of Technology, an adapted or alternative form of examination can be provided. The course is assessed through an evaluation of professional competence, individual written assignment, simulation, seminar and the practical National Clinical Final Examination for the Degree of Bachelor of Science in Nursing. The grading criteria are specified in the study guide. As concerns the clinical practice, only one re-examination opportunity/relocation is permitted for the course. Further relocation/re-examination opportunities may be granted if special reasons to do so exist. "Special" reasons are the reasons set out in regulations from the Swedish National Agency for Higher Education, HSVFS 1999:1. To pass the course, the learning outcomes must be met. This means that the student must achieve approved results in the course and actively participate in its compulsory parts. Grades are determined by the examiner.

Unauthorized aids during exams and assessments

If a student, by using unauthorized aids, tries to mislead during an exam or when a study performance is to be assessed, disciplinary measures may be taken. The term "unauthorized aids" refers to aids that the teacher has not previously specified as permissible aids and that may assist in solving the examination task. This means that all aids not specified as permissible are prohibited. The Swedish version has interpretative precedence in the event of a conflict.

Remarks

The course is given at the undergraduate level within the context of supplementary training for nurses, and entails clinical practice. Special entry requirements mean that the student must have received passing grades on all prerequisite courses. The specific entry requirements determining when the placement may be conducted in quarter 2 must have been met no later than the August re-sit period. This course, which contains modules with clinical practice (clinical practice modules), is subject to Specific Rules for Clinical Practice, pursuant to a decision by the Head of the Department of Health, Education and Technology, Luleå University of Technology.
