Course Aim

On completion of the course, the student should be able to:

- suggest, explain and characterise appropriate nursing interventions and medically indicated measures based on an evidence-based working method
- describe and explain the organisation and management of work within emergency care
- discuss and give examples of ethical positions in emergency care
- describe how acute, seriously ill individuals and their families can experience their changed life situations
- formulate relevant research issues
- explain the scientific theoretical basis of research issues
- critically review and evaluate research results and reports related to emergency care
- apply current laws and regulations
- document care and nursing
- document scientifically
