Entry requirements

Academic studies of at least 120 credits. Good knowledge in English, equivalent to English 6.

Selection

The selection is based on 30-285 credits

Course Aim

After completion of the course you should be able to:

- Describe and exemplify different types of projects, project roles, project management perspectives and project management tools.
- Analyze and predict the possible outcomes of implementing different types of project management and project management tools in specific situations.
- Reflect based on personal experience from working in projects and the "state of the art" from the literature in the areas of project management and project methodology, as to what characterizes project management skills of the individual manager as well as in the company.

Contents

In the course, students work with all stages of project planning and management both in theory and practice .

Realization

Each course occasion's language and form is stated and appear on the course page on Luleå University of Technology's website.

After an introduction of different aspects related to project management the students will work in project groups with solving practical project management problems and constructing a detailed and reality based implementation plan for an industrial firm.

Examination

If there is a decision on special educational support, in accordance with the Guideline Student's rights and obligations at Luleå University of Technology, an adapted or alternative form of examination can be provided. Examination is accomplished through compulsory assignments to be done individually and in group.

Unauthorized aids during exams and assessments

If a student, by using unauthorized aids, tries to mislead during an exam or when a study performance is to be assessed, disciplinary measures may be taken. The term "unauthorized aids" refers to aids that the teacher has not previously specified as permissible aids and that may assist in solving the examination task. This means that all aids not specified as permissible are prohibited. The Swedish version has interpretative precedence in the event of a conflict.



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Remarks

Due to similar content, the course can not be included in a degree together with the courses O7008N, O0002N (IEO026) or other course with similar content. Students must register for the courses themselves, or contact ETKS educational administration eduetks@ltu.se, not later than three days after the quarter commences. Failure to do so can result in the place being lost. This rule also applies to students with a guaranteed place.
