After successfully completing the course, the student is expected to be able to:

- describe central concepts in nursing in psychiatric care
- describe and reflect on the experience of living with mental illness based on the concepts of health and suffering
- Describe, discuss and present reasons about the importance of the relationship in psychiatric care
- identify individual needs of individuals with mental illness
- describe, explain, apply and critically review qualitative methods in the research process
- document in a scientific manner

Realization

Examination

The successful attainment of the objectives for the course is assessed via seminars and written reports. The grading criteria for Pass or Pass with honors (G, VG) is stated in the Study Guide.

Unauthorized aids during exams and assessments

If a student, by using unauthorized aids, tries to mislead during an exam or when a study performance is to be assessed, disciplinary measures may be taken. The term “unauthorized aids” refers to aids that the teacher has not previously specified as permissible aids and that may assist in solving the examination task. This means that all aids not specified as permissible are prohibited. The Swedish version has interpretative precedence in the event of a conflict.
