Course Aim

On completion of the course, the student should be able to: Knowledge and understanding

- describe symptoms, diagnostics and treatment of dementia
- describe drug treatment for dementia
- describe and concretise nursing in dementia
- describe and concretise the meaning of cross-cultural care in dementia
- describe and concretise methods and strategies to promote quality of life and support for relatives
- explain the nurse's profession and domain within dementia care

Skills and abilities

- independently identify problems and critically analyse symptoms of dementia and explain diagnostics, treatment and nursing in dementia
- independently plan, carry out, lead, supervise and evaluate nursing in dementia
- coordinate different professionals' actions in the care/nursing of the patient and their relatives to achieve teamwork
- independently search and critically review knowledge development in nursing of dementia
- independently be responsible for support of the relatives
