### **Course Aim**

The goal of the course is advancement in nursing with a focus on the experience of being ill. The student should, on completion of the course, based on science, current research and development be able to:

- 1. Show knowledge in and systematic understanding of nursing research and the depth and current specialist knowledge in research focusing on illness.
- 2. Propose and defend the application of scientific methodology and approach in the specific field.
- 3. Critically, independently and with scientific rigor to conduct scientific analysis, critical evaluation and synthesis with a focus on the needs of people with illness and their spouses.
- 4. Oral and written, and with scientific rigor present and discuss research findings and theories regarding illness experience, and knowledge that is the basis for these.
- 5. Evaluate and assess the scientific possibilities, limitations, and its role in society, and to be able to apply scientific knowledge to transform research in nursing in such a way that the needs of persons with illness and their spouses is met.

### **Contents**

The course focuses on the experience of living with illness from the ill persons, the families and healthcare personnel's perspective. The core of the course will be on the ill persons needs from a nursing perspective with emphasis on the transition, change in bodily experience, suffering, and the meaning of the relationship for health and treatment of illness.

## Realization

Each course occasion's language and form is stated and appear on the course page on Luleå University of Technology's website.

The course will be conducted with lectures, study assignments, and an individual written examination.
