Course Aim

After completing the course, students must be able to:

- Demonstrate the ability to use research synthesis as a scientific process
- Reflect on research ethical aspects related to the scientific process in systematic literature summaries
- Reflect on the contribution that literature summaries bring to their own main subject area
- Demonstrate the ability to apply critical reasoning to methods related to systematic literature summaries
