Course Aim

After completing the course the student shall be able to make decisions concerning supporting approaches and methods that can be used in different phases of a crises reaction. The student shall also be able to decide when an acute crisis phase has developed into a normal phase. The student shall also be able to communicate and cooperate with individuals and organizations in different critical situations.

Contents

Analysis of different threats in the environment and the life cycle.
How do people react to different threats?
How should we meet people in different critical situations?
How should we communicate efficiently with individuals and organizations?

Realization

The course contains lectures, group discussions and a project work to be presented in written format.
