Course Aim

After the course the student should be able to: - independently make a literature-based or an empirical thesis. - orally and in writing present and defend a literature-based or an empirical thesis.

Contents

Independently make a literature-based och empirical thesis.

Realization

Each course occasion's language and form is stated and appear on the course page on Luleå University of Technology's website.

To accomplish the thesis the student is offered 7 clock hours of supervision. The supervisor is appointed by the department. The supervisor and the student are supposed to make a formal agreement with respect to a supervision schedule and the content of the supervision. The agreement should be set up in a written form and signed by both the student and the supervisor. Manuscript and other written material the student want the supervisor to read should be handed in to the supervisor no less than 1 week prior to a, in beforehand, scheduled meeting with the supervisor. The supervision can take place as face-to-face meetings and/or by the means of e-mail or telephone. The student has the right to claim supervision within 3 semesters from the first time they were registered for this course.

Examination

If there is a decision on special educational support, in accordance with the Guideline Student's rights and obligations at Luleå University of Technology, an adapted or alternative form of examination can be provided. The thesis should be presented and defended at a mandatory seminar. Such a seminar takes place at the end of every semester. The supervisor reports to the examiner when the thesis is ready for the seminar and gives his/her permission to hand in the thesis to examiner for the examining.

To pass the course the student shall participate in compulsory meetings and seminars, including one seminar for presentation and defense and one as opponent. Further participation in compulsory meetings and seminars as decided by the supervisor. To pass the course further requires e-publishing of the thesis in accordance with the rules of LTU and that the thesis is completed no later than 12 calendar months after the course has formally ended. The student can however only utilize further supervision 6 calendar months after the course has formally ended.

Remarks

The form \"Registrering av examensarbete\" has to be completed and an advisor appointed before starting the thesis project work

Students must register for the courses themselves, or contact ETKS educational administration eduetks@ltu.se, not later than five days after the quarter commences. Failure to do so can result in the place being lost. This rule also applies to students with a guaranteed place.
