The student shall understand and critically reflect over his/her own personality- and value pattern in leader- and co-workers functions

Contents

The course deals with general theoretical views with focus on the leader skills, co-workers, and the situation.

Realization

Each course occasion's language and form is stated and appear on the course page on Luleå University of Technology's website.

Lectures, seminars, personality test with a written statement. The student is also doing an individual project where he/she is interviewing at least one manager/leader.

Examination
