### Main field of study

Industrial and Management Engineering

## Entry requirements

In order to meet the general entry requirements for first cycle studies you must have successfully completed upper secondary education and documented skills in English language and completed courses of at least 60 credits in the subject area Industrial Business and Management with at least the grade Pass. This must include the following courses: Industrial management with a sustainability perspective (G0010N) 7,5 credits, Industrial management (E0009N) 7,5 credits and Industrial management control and finance (R0028N) 7,5 credits, or equivalent knowledge.

## Selection

The selection is based on 1-165 credits.

## Course Aim

Upon completion of the course, the student should be able to design management control systems for organizations. The student should also be able to analyze the relationships between the design of the control system and behavioural consequences thereof.

## Contents

This course covers traditional and modern theories and tools for management control.

## Realization

Each course occasion's language and form is stated and appear on the course page on Luleå University of Technology's website.

Teaching mainly consists of lectures, tutorials and seminars. In the lectures, the course's knowledge-related and theoretical content is highlighted, which is intended to form the basis for solving practically oriented tasks that are also covered in seminars. The tutorial sessions are intended to provide support during the process.

## Examination

If there is a decision on special educational support, in accordance with the Guideline Student's rights and obligations at Luleå University of Technology, an adapted or alternative form of examination can be provided.

The course objectives are examined via a project task that must be solved in writing and orally in a group. The project task must be completed during the reading period that the course is given in order for a passing grade (grade 3) to be issued. For grades 4 and 5, there is an additional individual examination which can be written and/or oral. All possible re-examination is individual and takes place at the course's regular re-examination times.

## Unauthorized aids during exams and assessments

If a student, by using unauthorized aids, tries to mislead during an exam or when a study performance is to be assessed, disciplinary measures may be taken. The term “unauthorized aids” refers to aids that the teacher has not previously specified as permissible aids and that may assist in solving the examination task. This means that all aids not specified as permissible are prohibited. The Swedish version has interpretative precedence in the event of a conflict.

## Remarks

Students must register for the courses themselves, or contact ETKS educational administration [eduetks@ltu.se](mailto:eduetks@ltu.se), not later than three days after the quarter commences. Failure to do so can result in the place being lost. This rule also applies to students with a guaranteed place.

Due to similar content, the course can not be included in a degree together with the courses R0016N or other courses with similar content.
