## Entry requirements

In order to meet the general entry requirements for first cycle studies you must have successfully completed upper secondary education and documented skills in English language and completed courses of at least 30 credits in the subject area Business Administration with at least the grade Pass, where the courses Management of business (O0017N) 7,5 credits, Introductory Course Accounting and Control (R0008N) 7,5 credits, Models for Management Control (R0009N) 7,5 credits, or equivalent knowledge should be included. The course Principles of Marketing (M0015N) 7,5 credits, or equivalent courses are also recommended.

## Selection

The selection is based on 1-165 credits.

## Course Aim

After completing the course, the student should be able to:

- calculate, analyze and draw conclusions about the financial position and performance of organizations based on accounting information
- with support of relevant frameworks and theories, conduct analyzes of the practice of leadership
- identify and propose measures that can contribute to the successful management of activities in organizations based on completed analyzes of accounting information and practices of leadership

## Contents

The course consists of two parts that separate and together are central to achieving successful management of organizations. In one part, accounting-based information is used to calculate basic financial relationships and financial key performance indicators. The outcome of the calculations is later used as a basis for more in-depth analyzes and conclusions about past and future financial position and performance. In the other part, attention is directed to the exercise of leadership as an important part of the both understanding and practice of successful management. In this part, frameworks and theories are used to analyze leadership in theory and in practice. These analysis will ultimately function as well-founded knowledge and support in order to identify and suggest measures that can contribute to the successful management of organizations.

## Realization

Each course occasion's language and form is stated and appear on the course page on Luleå University of Technology's website.

The course is divided into modules that consists of different parts that are central for the student in order to achieve the course aim. The structure allows both a high degree of self-study as well as opportunities to take part in scheduled teacher-led teaching. The student can decide the way to approach the course.

Each module includes recorded lectures, video-clips, materials, exercises and quizzes for self-testing. Additional course literature can also be made available in the course modules.

The teacher-led time consists of lectures, lessons, questions and question time, and exercises with accompanying tutorials and seminars. The course also contains non-compulsory exercises that are relatively extensive and these must be completed in groups. The size of the groups is stated in the course's study instructions, which will be available at the start of the course. The exercises end with presentations and seminars where the group's solutions are presented and discussed. In connection with this, the group's performance is also assessed.

## Examination

If there is a decision on special educational support, in accordance with the Guideline Student's rights and obligations at Luleå University of Technology, an adapted or alternative form of examination can be provided. The course is examined via a written individual exam. For the course's non-compulsory exercises to be performed in groups, examination marks may be awarded depending on the level of achievement. These examination points can be credited to the course's regular exam. After completing the course, any examination points obtained from the current course round will not be valid.

## Unauthorized aids during exams and assessments

If a student, by using unauthorized aids, tries to mislead during an exam or when a study performance is to be assessed, disciplinary measures may be taken. The term "unauthorized aids" refers to aids that the teacher has not previously specified as permissible aids and that may assist in solving the examination task. This means that all aids not specified as permissible are prohibited. The Swedish version has interpretative precedence in the event of a conflict.

## Remarks

Students must register for the courses themselves, or contact ETKS educational administration [eduetks@ltu.se](mailto:eduetks@ltu.se), no later than three days after the quarter commences. Failure to do so can result in the place being lost. This rule also applies to students with a guaranteed place.

Due to overlap, the course cannot be included in the degree together with E0010N, O0014N or other course with similar content.
