Completed courses of 120 credits, of which at least 60 credits in the subject area Business Administration, with at least the grade Pass. Good knowledge in English, equivalent to English 6.

The selection is based on 30-285 credits

Course Aim

After passing the course the student shall be able to:

- identify, describe and analyze tools within finance and financial instruments
- · describe and analyze how prices, foreign currency- and interest rate risk affects multinational companies
- identify, describe and analyze concepts within international capital budgeting

Contents

In addition to offer the fundamental knowledge and tools in finance and the financial instruments for making investment decisions, the course offers a thorough treatment of price, foreign currency- and interest rate risk management practices of multinational corporations. The focus is on financing in global markets, economic currency exposure and capital structure, and international capital budgeting with global asset pricing frameworks.

Realization

Each course occasion's language and form is stated and appear on the course page on Luleå University of Technology's website.

The course contains lectures, seminars, group work, cases and/or project work. Teaching might be in English.
