Entry requirements

In order to meet the general entry requirements for first cycle studies you must have successfully completed upper secondary education and documented skills in English language and completed the following courses with at least the grade Pass: Audio Technology 1 (S0016F) 15 credits, Audio Technology 2 (S0017F) 15 credits, Epistemology within Audio Technology (S0042F) 7.5 credits and one of the following courses: Audio electronics 1 (S0013F) 7.5 credits, Acoustics for sound production (L0011A) 7.5 credits, or equivalent knowledge.

Selection

The selection is based on 1-165 credits.

Course Aim

After the course the student should be able to:

- from given conditions act as a sound engineer in various forms of productions
- identify the differences between different methods , solutions and cultures that exist in a variety of activities in audio production
- describe a range of current audio technology research questions
- from given preconditions act as supervisor at Audio Production
- reflect on their own knowledge and identify their need of further knowledge and skills

Contents

The course contains six elements that, together, will provide the knowledge and skills needed to achieve the course's objectives: • Work-based learning, where the student conducts his / her studies in a professional environment in which the student performs sound engineering work and critically reflects on the methods and processes used in this environment. • Study trip - Study visit in Stockholm at cost price • Study trip - AES Convention in Europe at cost price • Function as sound technician in productions and participation in recording seminar with own recording • Guidance of another student on sound productions • Reflection on own knowledge development

Realization

Each course occasion's language and form is stated and appear on the course page on Luleå University of Technology's website.

The course is conducted at companies in the audio industry and through assignments at LTU in the form of recordings, concerts and radio / TV productions. Two study trips at cost price.

Examination

If there is a decision on special educational support, in accordance with the Guideline Student's rights and obligations at Luleå University of Technology, an adapted or alternative form of examination can be provided. Written reports and oral presentations.

Unauthorized aids during exams and assessments

If a student, by using unauthorized aids, tries to mislead during an exam or when a study performance is to be assessed, disciplinary measures may be taken. The term "unauthorized aids" refers to aids that the teacher has not previously specified as permissible aids and that may assist in solving the examination task. This means that all aids not specified as permissible are prohibited. The Swedish version has interpretative precedence in the event of a conflict.

Remarks

Students must register for the courses themselves, or contact ETKS educational administration eduetks@ltu.se, not later than three days after the quarter commences. Failure to do so can result in the place being lost. This rule also applies to students with a guaranteed place.
