Course Aim

Further, the student should be able to apply this knowledge in order to independently conduct studies of political phenomena

Contents

The course is an intermediate course which deals with contemporary political philosophy and theory.

Realization

Each course occasion's language and form is stated and appear on the course page on Luleå University of Technology's website.

Teaching consists of lectures and seminars. The student will have opportunity to train oral and written presentation, teamwork and participation in seminars.

Examination

Written exams, seminars and group assignments. Grading system: Fail, Pass or Pass with Honour. Students who have failed an examination on five occasions will not be allowed further resits.
