Entry requirements

In order to meet the general entry requirements for first cycle studies you must have successfully completed upper secondary education and documented skills in English language and completed at least 60 credits in the subject Psychology or Sociology, and completed the following courses with at least a passing grade; Methods in sociology I (S0047A) 15 credits or Qualitative methods in social sciences 1 (P0072A) 7,5 credits and Quantitative methods in social sciences 1 (P0073A) 7,5 credits alternatively Methods in Social Sciences 1 (P0045A) 15 credits, or equivalent.

Selection

The selection is based on 1-165 credits.

Course Aim

The students should after they finished the course be able to show a more profound understanding of investigation research practices from a sociological and psychological perspective. Students should also be able to evaluate data and methods in investigations.

Contents

The course gives knowledge in social scientific methods, qualitative as well as quantitative to accomplish and work with evaluations.

Realization

Each course occasion's language and form is stated and appear on the course page on Luleå University of Technology's website.

The teaching takes the form of mainly lectures and different forms of seminars that complement the compulsory course literature. Group training and field studies can be included.

Examination

If there is a decision on special educational support, in accordance with the Guideline Student's rights and obligations at Luleå University of Technology, an adapted or alternative form of examination can be provided. Take-home examination 4 hp, Seminars 3,5 hp

Unauthorized aids during exams and assessments

If a student, by using unauthorized aids, tries to mislead during an exam or when a study performance is to be assessed, disciplinary measures may be taken. The term "unauthorized aids" refers to aids that the teacher has not previously specified as permissible aids and that may assist in solving the examination task. This means that all aids not specified as permissible are prohibited. The Swedish version has interpretative precedence in the event of a conflict.

Remarks

Students must register for the courses themselves, or contact ETKS educational administration eduetks@ltu.se, not later than three days after the quarter commences. Failure to do so can result in the place being lost. This rule also applies to students with a guaranteed place.
