Entry requirements

In order to meet the general entry requirements for first cycle studies you must have successfully completed upper secondary education and documented skills in English language and completed courses of at least 45 credits from the Bachelor Programme in Audio Technology with at least the grade Pass, or equivalent knowledge.

Selection

The selection is based on 1-165 credits.

Course Aim

Enable specialization in a topic within audio technology that is not covered in the program courses. Develop deeper knowledge or (greater) practical experience of an audio technology topic than is possible through the program courses.

Contents

- Learn about an acquired topic
- · Gain applied experience by developing a project around that acquired topic
- Learn from assessing the project
- Develop skills to conceive and manage a project independently

Realization

Each course occasion's language and form is stated and appear on the course page on Luleå University of Technology's website.

Independent study and meetings with a supervisor

Examination

If there is a decision on special educational support, in accordance with the Guideline Student's rights and obligations at Luleå University of Technology, an adapted or alternative form of examination can be provided. Coursework is examined continuously and proceeds in the order of the prov numbers/phases. Prov numbers must be completed in sequence. The required work includes written reflective reports and a presentation, as well as, the project.

Unauthorized aids during exams and assessments

If a student, by using unauthorized aids, tries to mislead during an exam or when a study performance is to be assessed, disciplinary measures may be taken. The term "unauthorized aids" refers to aids that the teacher has not previously specified as permissible aids and that may assist in solving the examination task. This means that all aids not specified as permissible are prohibited. The Swedish version has interpretative precedence in the event of a conflict.



Remarks

Students must register for the courses themselves, or contact ETKS educational administration eduetks@ltu.se, not later than three days after the quarter commences. Failure to do so can result in the place being lost. This rule also applies to students with a guaranteed place.
