Entry requirements

In order to meet the general entry requirements for first cycle studies you must have successfully completed upper secondary education and documented skills in English language and completed the following coruses with at least a passing grade; Basic Theory in Sociology (S0015A) 7,5 credits, Organisation and work sociology (S0016A) 7,5 credits, Basic Socialpsychology (S0052A) 7,5 credits, Essay writing in sociology (S0060A) 7,5 credits, Current sociological research (S0061A) 7,5 credits, Contemporary sociological theory (S0022A) 7,5 credits, Social Psychology II (S0025A) 7,5 credits and Applied sociological analysis and methods (S0059A) 15 credits, or equivalent. It is recommended that the applicants have basic knowledge of Methods in sociology I (S0047A) 15 credits.

Selection

The selection is based on 1-165 credits.

Course Aim

After passing the course, the student must be able to:

- Explain the meaning of central concepts, theories and perspectives within sociological theory;
- Use sociological concepts and theories to understand social phenomena;
- Compare and reflect on the sociological knowledge that different theories and concepts generate;
- Communicate sociological theoretical thinking orally and in writing.

Contents

The course provides in-depth knowledge of sociological theory development through the studying of a number of central modern sociological works.

Realization

Each course occasion's language and form is stated and appear on the course page on Luleå University of Technology's website.

Is mainly in the form of lectures and seminars. The seminars are mandatory.

Examination

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If there is a decision on special educational support, in accordance with the Guideline Student's rights and obligations at Luleå University of Technology, an adapted or alternative form of examination can be provided.

Examination is done through an individual take-home examination and seminars.



Unauthorized aids during exams and assessments

If a student, by using unauthorized aids, tries to mislead during an exam or when a study performance is to be assessed, disciplinary measures may be taken. The term "unauthorized aids" refers to aids that the teacher has not previously specified as permissible aids and that may assist in solving the examination task. This means that all aids not specified as permissible are prohibited. The Swedish version has interpretative precedence in the event of a conflict.
