Course content and structure

A Master's degree in Digital Curation (120 ECTS) requires 90 ECTS in the major subject, including thesis of 30 ECTS. The programme contains courses of at least 90 ECTS on advanced level. The language of teaching is English. Courses included in the programme spans topics such as long-term digital preservation and access, digital archives, standards and interoperability, organisation of preservation work, project work and investigations.

The programme is intended to be a EU-master in collaboration with other European universities. If the EU-master becomes a reality it will be possible to study one semester on one of the collaborating universities.

Entry requirements

General entry requirements, second cycle

Specific entry

Bachelor's degree of at least 180 ECTS or equivalent academic qualifications with at least 60 ECTS in Systems Science, Computer Science, Media Technology, Informatics, Archival Science or Library and Information Science or a closely related area and a final thesis of 15 ECTS. Students with a background in Archival Science or Library and Information Science are required to have 30 ECTS in Systems Science, Computer Science, Informatics, Media Technology or similar discipline.

Applicants must have documented skills in English corresponding to the level of English in Swedish upper secondary education (English B).

Proven language proficiency in English, can for example be shown by an international English test as TOEFL or IELTS. Some specified university studies can also be equivalent.
